Your tasks:

- You love sports. Experience with rowing including regatta experience is desirable, but not necessarily needed. If a candidate is genuinely interested, we can introduce him/her to the sport and terminology.
- You are willing to be on the river "Lesum" early in the morning in all weather conditions.
- Maybe you already have experience in supervision of children and youths?
- You enjoy spending your weekends with training, regattas or other events.
- Maybe you even have a driver's licence.







The details:

- This is a full-time position (38.5 hrs/week) lasting from August 1st 2017 until 31st of July 2018 (or depending on the starting point later). Half of the time is spent with/for the club, the other half with Jacobs University.
- The most hours will be used during summer and weekends, which can be evened out during the other times.
- There is the possibility for you to row.
- You are taking part in FSJ-courses, and you can get an Übungsleiterschein as well as a C-coach-licence.
- We can help you with the apartment search, if needed.
